Photographic Competition

GUIDANCE

The Heraldry Society exists to promote and encourage the study and enjoyment of the science of heraldry, armory, chivalry and all kindred subjects and disciplines.

Entries should feature strong heraldic content – either conventional or extraordinary – and preferably demonstrate its setting.

RULES

1. The competition is open to anyone anywhere.
2. Each entrant may submit up to two separate entries, each of different subjects and no larger than A4. Entries must be the entrant's own original unpublished work and may be the result of traditional roll film or digital exposure with enhancements no greater than standard darkroom practices would achieve.
3. Each entry must be mounted on black card or stiff paper with the full name and address of the entrant, together with any title or legend, fixed to the back. *Note: the judges are not made aware of entrants' identity.*
4. Entrants must retain the originals or copies of their entries.
5. An email address – or a stamped self-addressed envelope – should be enclosed for acknowledgement of safe receipt. A further stamped, self-addressed envelope should be enclosed if the entry's return is required at the close of the Competition.
6. Copyright remains the property of the entrant, but by signing the Entry Form the entrant grants to The Heraldry Society without charge the right to display and publish their accredited entries without alteration in any or all of the Society's advertising, publicity and publications.

Entrants' personal data is not sold or made available to third parties and the Competition is compliant with data protection regulations.

The winner will be notified by email or post and invited to receive the cash prize, together with a certificate, at a London meeting of the Society.

Results will be published in the December issue of *The Heraldry Gazette*.
